2025 Cub Creek Community Garden Rights, Privileges, Responsibilities, and Obligations

- 1. You are expected to maintain your plot, which includes:
 - Controlling diseases
 - Controlling insects
 - Pulling weeds (do not allow weeds to go to seed)
 - Keeping produce harvested
 - Weighing and recording produce weight in notebook (Town of Wilkesboro's report is generated by this information)
 - Cleaning your plot when done for the season

If you are notified 3 times per the office staff to comply to any of these responsibilities and you have not, you will automatically forfeit your plot for the current year and the Wilkes Master Gardeners will take control of the plot. You will also lose privileges for the upcoming year as well.

- 2. Do not alter the wood frame around your garden plot.
- 3. All items below are to be used at the community garden only, please do not remove from the premises:
 - Tools
 - Seeds
 - Plants
 - Supplies
- 4. Maintaining and securing of the garden property:
 - Wash all tools before returning them to the shed
 - Empty all carts of debris before leaving (each time you use them)
 - Wash out carts if excessively dirty
 - Lock the shed before leaving
 - Make sure all garden gates are locked before leaving
- 5. 2 wire cages are available to stake vining crops such as tomatoes per plot. At the end of the season, please store them in your plot for the next season.
- 6. Only use pesticides provided in the shed for your plot (outside pesticides are not allowed) and please be mindful of pesticide drift.
- 7. When watering plots, please make sure hoses do not stretch across other plots.
- 8. Do not harvest from another plot unless given permission from the plot owner.
- 9. If extended absences are anticipated, please notify Wilkes Extension Office at 336-651-7333 so plots can be maintained and produce can be harvested and donated. Help is available but only if you ask.
- 10. Dogs are not allowed inside the fenced garden area.
- 11. No smoking inside the fenced garden area.
